Dear Colleagues,

I would like to notify you of the 13th Open Mathematical Olympiad of the Belarusian-Russian University (International Student Olympiad) which is scheduled to be held at the Belarusian-Russian University (Mogilev, Belarus) on February 22-24, 2023.

Teams of higher education institutions composed of not more than two participants (undergraduates or postgraduate students) and one supervisor are invited to take part in the Olympiad.

I would like to draw your attention to the following information:

- the Olympiad will be held as a competition with individual classification;
- winners (holders of gold, silver and bronze medals) of the Open Mathematical Olympiads of the Belarusian-Russian University held in the past years may be additionally included into the HEI team over the quota (two participants);
- the Olympiad is supposed to be held in one round in the form of testing (30 tasks in the form of tests to be fulfilled within 5 hours);
- the tasks will contain problems from the following areas of mathematics: algebra, theory of numbers, analysis (real or complex), analytical geometry, combinatorial analysis, ordinary differential equations.

Working languages of the Olympiad are English and Russian.

The registration fee for the participation in the Olympiad is 70 euros per team. Travel expenses, meals and accommodation of non-resident participants and supervisors are paid by the institution sending them.
